I play football every Sunday.








She eats fruit every day.

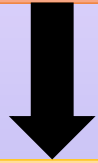

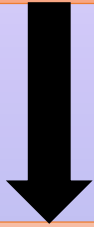
